

# The waste trend

2024

## The amount of household waste is decreasing

The collected and treated amount of household waste from households and businesses amounted to just over 4.5 million tones in 2024, which is a decrease of 1 percent compared to 2023. This corresponds to 426 (431) kilograms per person.

The amount of collected food waste increased by 8 percent compared to 2023 amounting to 44 kilograms per person. The residual waste decreased by 3 percent amounting to 143 kilograms per person. In total, the amount of food and residual waste per person decreased by 17 percent since 2015.

Collected amounts of bulky waste decreased by 1.5 percent by 151 (154) kilograms per person. Bulky plastic to material recycling has increased by almost 20 percent.

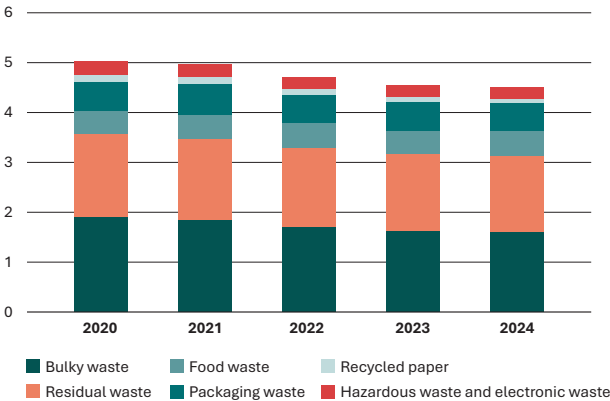

### Total amount of collected household waste, million tons 2020-2024

Household waste refers to the waste generated by households and businesses that falls under the municipal waste responsibility according to Chapter 15, Section 20 of the Environmental Code. Compared to the concept of municipal waste, it includes construction and demolition waste from households, while waste from park maintenance and street cleaning is not included.
